The 125 Reunion created a lot of interest and lot of former pupils came along for a tour round the school and had chance to reconnect with old friends. We now have a 125 Facebook page where we can advertise our events and keep in touch with the former Pupils. Which is a great resource. The entrance money for that went to the Trinity Academy Charity so that was great too.

We are maintaining the links with Trinity Academicals Rugby Club and had our great Fun Day in August last year and this.
